GIUSEPPE ZANOTTI REOPENS IN BEVERLY HILLS.

Famed Italian shoe and accessory designer **Giuseppe Zanotti**'s loyal fan base reads like a who's who of Hollywood's most fashionable females. Beyoncé—who wowed fellow guests at the store's star-studded opening bash—stands tall in his platform heels; Jennifer Lopez opts for sexy strappy sandals; and Rihanna makes his sparkly baubles sing. And at the Italian designer's newly renovated Beverly Hills store, his well-heeled clientele have even more room to strut their stuff. Twice the size of the original space, the glamorous boutique blends classic and modern styles: marble, lacquered wood and brass finishes mingle with contemporary furniture and sleek metal hardware. Treasure Trove

Love Adorned, which just arrived on Santa Monica's Main Street, has an interesting—somewhat scandalous—origin. Owner Lori Leven opened almost two decades ago in NYC as a storefront to hide then-illegal tattoo parlor New York Adorned. Recently, both businesses grew too big and separated, giving Love Adorned its own bold identity, in both the original location and the new SaMo spot. Stocked with unique items from Leven's travels, the boutique carries handmade and antique jewelry, decor, apothecary items and more, ranging from \$5 to \$50,000. "I hunt down the artisans and craftspeople in every way imaginable," she says. Leven has plans for several exclusive collaborations, including a line of colorful, stone-driven pieces with Katie Finn of Elizabeth Street and a collection of scarves with local artists (Lou Zeldis and Nicholas Potash, among others). The New York-based trendsetter also intends to spend more time in L.A. "I want to spend time lying in the sand, staring at the sky in the desert, exploring the canyons, picking avocados off a tree and smelling night jasmine..."
